Outfitting your Road-iQ with the proper amount of and type of memory is crucial to meet the video storage needs of your application. The chart to the left displays the differences between the two types of additional memory options currently available for Road-iQ: Flash Drive and mSATA.

Flash Drive Memory is portable. You may plug it directly into the USB port of the Road-iQ or your 4G LTE enabled NetHub device. When you wish to view or save footage onto a desktop computer, you can simply remove the flash drive and take it with you. For added security you will receive a USB locking device to prevent theft or tampering with the drive.

mSATA is internal memory located inside the Road-iQ unit. Its size is similar to a business card. This memory option should not be removed from the Road-iQ unit and therefore is not portable like the flash drive. If you need memory storage above 500 GB and don't need to remove the device, mSATA is a more cost-effective option.



Note: Your iPad contains its own memory built-in that will save recorded driving footage. iPad memory varies in size, from 16 GB storage to 128 GB. You will need to take this into account when choosing how much additional memory you will need.
